International Keynote Speakers

Dr Donna Berry

Donna L. Berry, PhD, RN, AOCN®, FAAN is Director of the Phyllis F. Cantor Center for Research in Nursing and Patient Care Services at Dana-Farber Cancer Institute. She is also an Associate Professor of Medicine at Harvard Medical School. Recruited to Dana-Farber from the University of Washington in Seattle, Dr. Berry investigates the human experience of having a cancer diagnosis, ranging from making treatment decisions to managing cancer symptoms and side effects. Dr. Berry has lead a program of research, beginning in 1998, to improve the treatment decision making process for men with localized prostate cancer and their clinicians to ultimately improve health outcomes. In 2011, Dr. Berry was the recipient of the Distinguished Researcher Award from the Oncology Nursing Society. She also received the Ruth McCorkle Annual Award & Lecture from the Puget Sound Oncology Nursing Society as well as the Distinguished Scholar Award & Lecture from the University of Massachusetts Boston, College of Nursing.



Dr Michal Boyd

Dr Michal Boyd, RN, NP, ND, FCNA (NZ) is a Gerontology Nurse Practitioner and a Senior Lecturer with the Department of Geriatric Medicine at the University of Auckland, New Zealand. From 2006 to 2009, she was Clinical Leader for Community Services for Older Adults through Waitemata District Health Board (WDHB). She has been a provider, leader and researcher of care management and healthcare integration for older people since the early 1990's.
